Since we have no real courts, the courts will be chalked out on 12<sup>th</sup> St. in Carrizozo. The street is not really very level and there are a few cracks but it's the best we could do. There will be 6 tournament courts, with sketchy lines and portable nets. Construction barriers will separate the courts.

Each player will be assigned a number. The pairings will be called out, the court assigned and you will play for 12 minutes. Each player will then report their score to someone who thinks they are official, and then a new pairing and court will be assigned and a second 12-minute game will ensue. This will continue until every one has played their total games. Total games will depend on the number of participants.

At the end of the round, each players points will be tallied up by someone who thinks they are official and the one with the most points is crowned winner of this prestigious event. Second and third will be awarded too, but who wants to win that! It would be wise to check our math, as we are from Carrizozo. If there is a tie in points, a one game sudden death playoff will be had, with the tied players being able to pick a partner of their choice to help them battle it out for the winning spots.

As Carrizozo is unique, so to are our awards. They will be handmade charcutier boards, sans the food, in the shape of pickleball paddles, hand made by Mike Lagg, whose gallery and workshop you will be playing in front of.

Spots may be shared in the sessions if a player doesn't want to play every game, or if we have more players than spots, which is our hope!

One demo court will be available, where your loved ones that don't understand your passion for the game, can try it out for the first time. Balls and paddles will be provided at the Demo court along with very basic instruction.

There will be vendors for food and crafts, along with local business that will be open. ZoZo Pickleball will be selling shirts in our effort to raise money for new courts as well. All of the galleries will be open for families to browse when they tire of watching your athletic efforts. Burros will be displayed up and down the street for viewing and picture taking.
